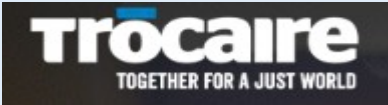
If your child was Baptized In Arklow, Johnstown or Castletown Parish and you don't have a Baptism Certificate we can check Parish Registers.
