Exam Prayer

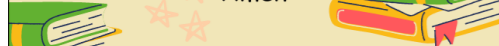
We think of all young people sitting their Exams and we wish them Good Luck.

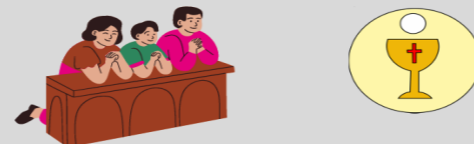
