


The Season of Creation, is marked throughout the Christian world from 1st September to 4th October the Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi and celebrates the joy of creation as well as encouraging awareness-raising initiatives to protect the natural environment. Pope Francis established 1st September as an annual World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation.

The theme for the Season of Creation 2021 is 'Restoring Our Common Home'. During this season we are asked to join together to celebrate creation and protect our common home (our world) through prayer, reflection and action. The global Christian family is called to awaken to the urgent need to heal our relationships with creation and with each other and to encourage our parish communities to do the same. Pope Francis will attend the

United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP26) in **Glasgow** in November. Scotland's Bishops confirmed the Pope's presence among other world leaders in a statement on their website.

The archbishop of Dublin has urged Catholics to help tackle the "climate catastrophe" in a 64-page pastoral letter. In his first **pastoral letter** since he was **installed** in Dublin in February, Archbishop Dermot Farrell encouraged his flock to undergo an "ecological conversion." "The purpose of this pastoral letter is to initiate a diocesan conversation about how all can contribute to the care of our common home and recognize the many dimensions attached to this challenge,"



Sod turned on Arklow Wastewater Treatment Plant

Irish Water, in partnership with Wicklow County Council, have marked the start of construction on a new state-of-the-art wastewater treatment plant that will provide wastewater treatment for the first time for the community of Arklow. When completed, the treatment plant will bring significant benefits to the local community in terms of protecting the environment and improving water quality in the River Avoca for angling, water sports and marine life. It will also act as an enabler for housing and support economic growth and development in the town.


