Everlasting is thy reign.

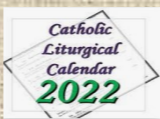
Hark! With loud peeling hymn

**St Teresa Benedicta of the Cross**

**(Edith Stein)** Born 1891 at Breslau (now Wroclaw, Poland) the youngest of seven children of a Jewish family. A brilliant student she gained her doctorate in philosophy at twenty five. Became a Catholic in 1922 and a Carmelite nun. Both Jewish and Catholic, she fled to Holland when the Nazis came to power but she was captured and sent to Auschwitz where she died in its gas chamber on 9th August 1942

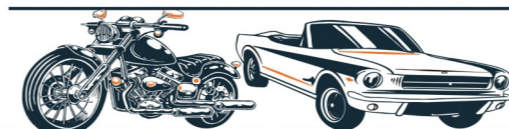
