Planning your Wedding



It is important to give three months notice of your intention to marry
it is common practice for a couple to book the church a long time in advance.
So it is important to contact the Parish Office to make sure the church and priest is available on the day you require.

Church Requirements: Church Law requires three months notice of your intention to marry. It is strongly recommended that couples preparing for marriage complete a pre-marriage course. Courses are run by Accord the Catholic Marriage Advisory Centre for the Diocese Tel 01 4780866 or www.accord.ie

Civil Requirements: When the couple have chosen the date, Church and Priest for their marriage (and confirmed these matters with the relevant Priest) they will then need to make an appointment to meet with any Civil Registrar in person to give notice of their intention to marry. This meeting with the Registrar must take place at least three months before the wedding in order to comply with the civil Requirements.
