CELEBRATION OF PUBLIC MASSES

9th October 2020

As we go to print the 4 Catholic Archbishops of Ireland have requested a meeting with the Taoiseach, Mícheál Martin TD. As you are aware, the Government has moved Ireland on to Level 3 in the fight against Covid 19. Since the schools and many businesses returned the numbers of people affected has risen.

Under Level 3 churches can remain open for private worship but not for public Mass. In June the Bishops succeeded in re-opening public Mass which had not been scheduled to re-commence until August. So it was great to see the community of believers assembling to celebrate the Mass, our central act of worship.

We, in Arklow parish, have been meticulous in the measures we adopted to safeguard our people according to recommended standards. We have very dedicated, well organized teams of Cleaners, Sanitisers, and Stewards who monitor our church on a daily and hourly basis. We have cordoned off our seating to adhere to 2 metre separation, we have provided sanitizers and masks at all entrances and exits, we bring Holy Communion to people in their seats, we have revised our operation of the shrines, and we have even changed our practice of Collections. Our church is professionally cleaned on a regular basis. We have spent thousands of Euros to keep the church open and safe.

To my knowledge there has been no case of Covid 19 due to attendance at Mass or at our beautiful spacious churches in Sts Mary & Peter, Arklow and St David's Johnstown.

We are happy to continue to hold Public Mass and to operate our safety procedures to the highest standards. We ask you to pray that the Archbishops are successful in their meetings with an Taoiseach. We also request you pray the Rosary every day during October with the intention of overcoming Covid 19. We look forward to having you back at Mass as soon as possible.

In the meantime you might like to send us any ideas you have as to how we can fulfil our mission during the coming months of November, Advent, and Christmas.
