## FEAST OF THE ASCENSION - 12th May

From Death to Eternal Life in Heaven In the Easter season we celebrate Jesus' victory over death. After his resurrection on Easter Sunday Jesus accompanied His friends and followers for 40 special days encouraging them and teaching them till He ascended into Heaven. He celebrated the Eucharist with them, reenacting His Last Supper when He gave them His Body and Blood as a prelude to Good Friday and His death on the Cross. But the ultimate point was His Resurrection. The Mass is the great gift of Jesus to us, associating us with His victory over death. When a person dies the greatest gift we can give them is the Requiem or Funeral Mass. No other prayer service or ceremony can surpass this gift of the Mass for the eternal happiness of the person who has died. In the Mass Jesus accompanies the dead person and leads them to Himself. Remember to give those who die the gift of a Funeral Mass!


