



**Did you know you could help our Parish increase the value of your donation and it wont cost you a penny?**

As a Parishioner if you have donated in excess of €250 in a given tax year Arklow Parish can claim up to 44.9% in a tax refund from the Revenue.

**Who can help increase the value of their donation?**

Any Parishioner who is also a taxpayer including anyone self- employed.

**What is involved? What do I need to do ?**

Contact Treasa the Parish Office. She will provide you with the CHY3 tax back form and guide you with its completion. Once completed the form is valid for 5 years.

**What information is required for the CHY3 form?**

Your PPS number and your signature is all that is required. Once this information is provided Treasa will take care of everything else on your behalf.

**Why take the time to request a CHY3 form and proceed?**

Completing the CHY3 form will cost you nothing nor will it impede on your Tax status

**BUT** the funding we unlock as an **eligible body which qualifies for a charitable tax exemption** in accordance with Section 207 TCA 1997 will allow the Parish to carry out additional maintenance and repairs to the Church we would not ordinarily be able to provide for.

A gentle reminder if you have already received a **CHY3 Form please** return it to Treasa in the Parish Office as the deadline for claiming tax refunds is fast approaching.
