"The Church must always be Pro-Life"

Archbishop Diarmuid Martin

The Archbishop has issued his statement on the defence of human life. He asks us to join in prayer in the coming days to touch hearts and commit our society to be Pro-Life in defending the lives of unborn children and in supporting women and men in the challenges they meet in accepting the joy of parenthood.

He says Ireland has a great record of protecting both the lives of the mother and the child. Repealing the Eighth Amendment is not about permitting limited abortion. It would permit abortion without restriction up to 12 weeks, but also abortion on physical and mental grounds up to 6 months.

Abortion legislation would be left entirely up to the Oireachtas. In future small parties could demand abortion be extended as part of a programme for government.

Repealing the 8th Amendment means the unborn would be left without Constitutional protection. For that reason he will be voting No.
