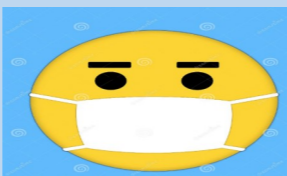


We are now looking for more volunteers to help out if you have time and would like to help please contact one of the Priests or Siobhán in the Parish Office.

### SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE KING

This Sunday is the last Sunday of the Church's liturgical year. On this Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. Each year we set aside this Sunday to reflect upon this title that we have given to Jesus. We dwell on a portion of the passion from the Gospel of John, which is also part of the Gospel reading proclaimed each year on Good Friday. King and kingdom may be appropriate terms for Jesus' mission and promise, but only by analogy. Jesus is king, but not the kind of king we imagine or expect. He was certainly not the kind of king Pilate feared he might be. Truth is another important theme in John's Gospel. We see it emphasized in the conclusion of the dialogue between Jesus and Pilate. Those who know the truth will recognize Jesus as king. Today's Gospel invites us to see with eyes of faith that we might recognize that Jesus, through his crucifixion and death, is indeed king and Savior of all.
