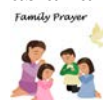
Interactive Family Prayer Stations

Requests for tickets for WMOF2018 have been overwhelming Within a week of tickets being released to the public, 400,000 tickets for the Closing Mass in Dublin's Phoenix Park were booked, all 45,000 tickets for Knock Shrine were booked within the first 4 hours and the Pastoral Congress in the RDS is now also fully booked, with a record-breaking 37,000 registrations. There has been over 10,000 overseas bookings. It is a record-breaking Word Meeting of Families with the highest number of people registered to the Pastoral Congress, the highest number of international pilgrims attending and the highest amount of children and young people attending! Official WMOF 2018 Icon of the Holy Family

Visitation to Arklow 30th July – 2nd August 2018

The word 'icon' is a Greek word meaning image or picture. When we hear the word 'icon' today, we probably think of all the icons on our computers, tablets and phones. When we click on an icon it takes us beyond the image or symbol, it brings us deeper into the programme it represents. It helps us to use the computer better, to do our work better. An Icon is a religious picture; they have been described as "prayers in paintings, "as windows to heaven". When we look at a religious icon, it brings us closer to God; it invites us to think, to imagine and to pray. It tells a story and helps us to deepen our friendship with God; it connects us to his Love.

Pope Francis encourages us to look at this beautiful Icon of the Holy Family, which will soon be in our parish, to ponder what family means to us as Christians, and to pray with and for all families.

Let us find some time in our busy lives to come and gaze on the Icon. Maybe we could take this as a mini retreat, a time to talk to God about the blessings, joys, and struggles of family life and to listen to what God is calling us to be.
