Theme: The teaching of the Church on the Liturgy of the Word is expressed in these texts. Jesus states that the prophecy of Isaiah is fulfilled in himself: so the Scripture word is actualized for us each time it is proclaimed in church. Christ is really present in his Word. That Word challenges us to a renewal of life, as the people rediscovered their identity when Ezra read the Law to them. Those who serve as ministers of the Word will find the joy of the Lord to be their strength.

Reading 1. This passage tells of the events which marks the birth of Judasim. The word of God played an essential role within the 1st assembly of the Jewish people who were gathered in the desert.

Reading 2. St. Paul continues to speak of the gifts of the Spirit. He gives the example of the human body and how the different gifts of the Spirit should be used for the good of all the church.

Gospel: In this passage he stresses the power of the Spirit at work in Jesus. Jesus sees the fulfillment of the prophecy of Isaiah in his own immediate person and presence.
