" Our community of believers are happy to see social life return to normal after the scourge of Covid. We welcome the freedom of people to gather and join their friends and commend those who organise different events around the town.

It is a shame however that due to a lack of consideration many of our parishioners wishing to attend evening Mass are not accommodated when such festivals take place. Over a number of years, solid steel barriers are erected and our parishioners are prevented from coming to their weekly Mass. We would like to think that such restrictions are not deliberate. In anticipation of last weekend's festival, I wrote to Wicklow County Council expressing my concerns on our behalf. I regret to say that no effort was made to consult us to allow access to the church and to the Parochial House in spite of formal and informal attempts to raise this continuing issue.

We earnestly request that for all future festivals the organisers consult us in advance so that parishioners are not put in an impossible position and even forced to violate traffic laws."
