Noble Bell

We have commenced an upgrade of the structural steel support to the Noble Bell, located in the bell tower of the Church of Saint Mary and Peter, Arklow. The existing steel has served its purpose well for many decades. However, with the exposed location deteriorating the steel, remedial works to the bell support were considered essential.

The bell weighs 1.33 tons, was installed under the supervision of P.P. James Redmond and was blessed by Lord Archbishop Cullen on the 24th of June 1866. At the time of installation, the local fishermen who were most generous in the building of the Church, expected to hear the great bell of St Peter far out to sea. This would enable them to join in a prayer with their friends on land.

Timeframe: The work will take between four to six weeks.

Unfortunately, the bell will not be heard during the works. However, the new structural supports will ensure that the bell will be preserved upon completion for future generations. We look forward to hearing its powerful silvery tones ring around the Parish and out to sea for our fishermen before Easter 2023.
