Message from the Pastoral Parish Council

Hello! My name is Natalia, I am also on the Parish Council and I am the contact person for the prayer groups at our Church. These groups are an invaluable resource for fostering spiritual growth, building community, and fulfilling our mission of spreading the Gospel.

Our Church has several established prayer groups, including the Monday Prayer Group, a daily Rosary group that meets after the 10am Mass, the Legion of Mary, and the Rosary at the Grotto. Everyone is welcome to join any of these groups at any time.

Additionally, we have a team of volunteers who organise special prayer events. One notable initiative is the Rosary at the Grotto, which takes place every evening at 8pm. Other examples of our activities include the Stations of the Cross during Lent and the Alliance of the Two Hearts. These events featured wonderful prayers and meditations; we hope to have them again in our Church.

I also help to organise the Mass in Polish, which is held on the first Sunday of each month at 10:00 a.m. A priest comes from either Dublin or Wexford to lead the service. The readings and order of prayers are the same as in the Mass in English, making it easy to follow even for those who do not understand Polish. Everyone is very welcome to attend this Mass.

House Visits




