Edward Byrne was Archbishop of Dublin from 1921-1940. He was the son of a tenant farmer from Kilahurler in the Arklow Parish. Commencing his role as Archbishop of Dublin in 1921, Edward made an immense contribution to the newly formed Irish state. Archbishop, Edward used church funding to support the cash strapped state by; the establishment of schools in all parishes in

His diocese, and health clinics throughout the diocese.

He was responsible for the expansion of Dublin's public hospitals including the National Children's hospital in Crumlin and the establishment of St Vincent's in Elm Park.

In an era which was without social welfare support Archbishop Byrne was a staunch advocate of organisations like St Vincent De Paul and the Legion of Mary in their charitable works for Dublin's poor and homeless.


