

PROFILES

Canon John Piert

(70th Anniversary of Ordination)

Canon Piert is a native of Kilkenny. He was born on 11th October 1927, feast of St Canice, patron saint of Kilkenny. He was ordained for the Dublin Archdiocese on June 14th 1953 by Archbishop John Charles Mc Quaid. He lectured many future priests and bishops including Archbishop Diarmuid Martin.



He ministered in various parishes around the Dublin Archdiocese including Sutton, Sandyford, Castletown, and Wicklow before arriving in Johnstown, Arklow in 1998. He was appointed a Canon of the Metropolitan Chapter in 2007

Fr John Hayes

(60th Anniversary of Ordination)

Fr Hayes was born in February 1936. A native of Scarnagh in Arklow parish, he served with distinction in the diocese of Brentwood, as private secretary to Bishop Patrick Wall (1963-70) during the momentous years following the Second Vatican Council.



He has served in many parishes during his time as a priest including his last parish, Hornchurch in Essex. Fr Hayes was Director for the successful Brentwood Diocesan Lourdes Pilgrimage for many years and helped hundreds of pilgrims at Our Lady's Shrine. He continues to serve as Spiritual Director to Our Lady Queen of Peace praesidium of the Legion of Mary in Coolgreany.
