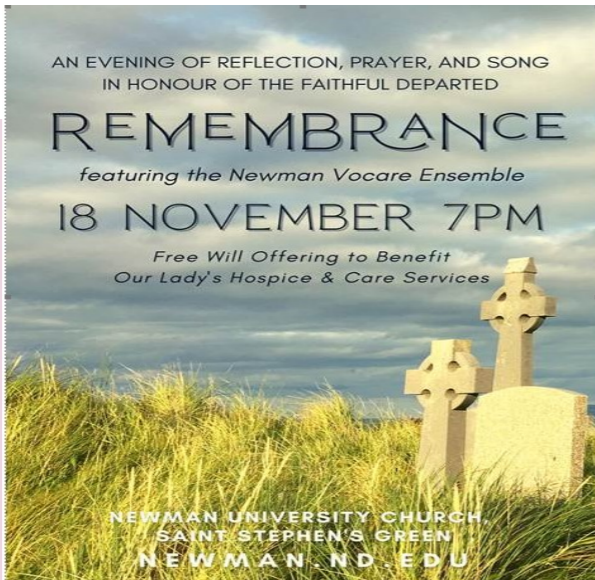


SHARE APPEAL SUNDAY

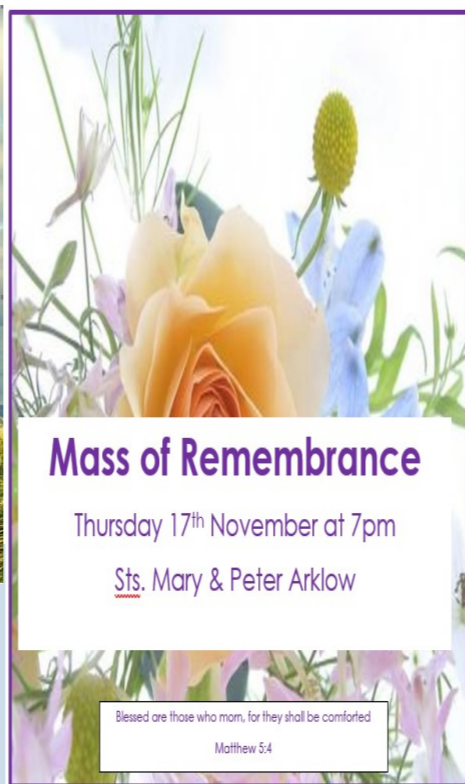

Sunday, November 13th

Marks the 6th Annual World Day of the Poor. The theme for this day is *For your sakes Christ became poor* (2 Cor 8:9). With these words, the Apostle Paul addresses the first Christians of Corinth to encourage their efforts to show solidarity with their brothers and sisters in need.

In his message for 2022, Pope Francis has emphasised a faith leading to action. He particularly highlights that need for our world to be in solidarity with those marginalised because of forced migration. Pope Francis's full message is available on the Vatican website.

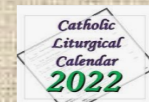

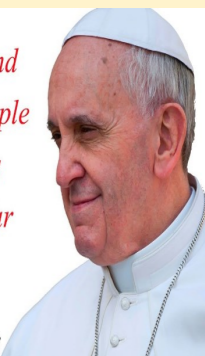
