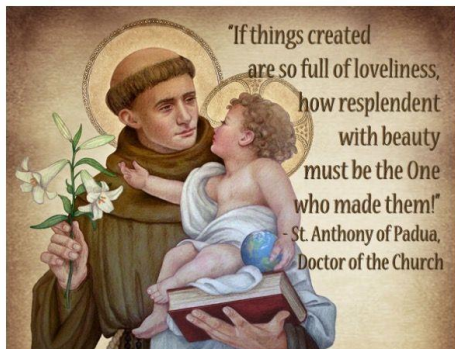

Trinity Sunday



Trinity Sunday, officially called "The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity," is one of the few celebrations of the Christian Year that commemorates a reality and doctrine rather than a person or event. On Trinity Sunday, Christians remember and honour the eternal God: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Trinity Sunday is celebrated the Sunday after Pentecost.

The relationships in the Trinity are relationships of love. The reflection on this mystery is not in terms of philosophy but of Christian living. The unity and harmony of the life in the Trinity is to be the aim of each community. Where love is, there God is.

Columba, the greatest and earliest of our missionaries, is one of the Patron Saints of Ireland. *Colum Cille* is noted for his love for people and for all living creatures.
